
Value Proposition Workshop by **Instituto Politécnico de Viana do Castelo (IPVC)**

Insights from the Workshop:

IPVC Inclusive School Project:

- is a socially inclusive project;
- fosters a community building for innovation and entrepreneurship;
- implement social entrepreneurship;
- strengthen cooperation with the community needs.

IPVC commitment with the community needs:

- enhancing the link between the academic community and the social and non-profit organizations sector, responding to real challenges;
