
BeyondScale objectives

- Capacity building working with HEInnovate in organisational development and regional engagement through "Inbound" and "Outbound" activity areas
- Establish and evolve a Community of Practice through the Buddy system
- Further development of the HEInnovate application and methodology (instrument and resource base) going beyond current use for organisational change and entrepreneurial agenda setting
- Accompanying research to better understand organisational change processes and use of HEInnovate in achieving change with a view to producing innovative learning models for higher education stakeholders and policy makes

The accompanying research in BeyondScale

A special feature of BeyondScale is the "Accompanying Research (AR)"

AR is:

- Scientific research on the shared topic (=organisational change) of the project partners to support them and to generate new knowledge....
- A knowledge hub in the project:
 - Providing projects partners with additional knowledge on their shared topic,
 - Pointing to good practices and new developments
 - Reflecting the experiences and outcomes of the partner projects in the light of the shared topic and the knowledge established.


The guiding questions for the AR

- How do change processes/organisational development processes towards implementing the entrepreneurial agenda in higher education institutions look like?
- What changes at the individual, group and organisational level does the change management need to facilitate to successfully implement the entrepreneurial agenda?
- And in what contexts do the *change management* work best?
- What barriers (at national, institutional, group and individual level) hinder the implementation of the entrepreneurial agenda? What factors (at national, institutional, group and individual level) support its implementation?
- How does the HEInnovate platform contribute to a successful implementation of the entrepreneurial agenda?





Project plan



- Identify good practices (=> policy briefs; case studies; guidelines; user stories)
- Development of indicators on impact of HEInnovate
- Add to HEInnovate Knowledge Base
- Disseminate research results (academic paper; working papers)
- Recommendations for upscaling
 HEInnovate platform
- Exchange experiences with other FLPs (interviews; surveys)
 - scoping or partners plans
 - Perform systematic literature review on organizational change (covering academic literature and HEInnovate resources)
