HEInnovate Lessons/results from the BeyondScale Forward-Looking Cooperation project

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On the HEInnovate statements & dimensions

- The <u>statements</u> are seen as too <u>broad</u> and not tailored to the individual institution, so they are mainly useful for the users to start a discussion in their institution and can be used to ask additional questions often <u>open questions</u>. Statements are the start of the journey.
- Statements are focusing on the HEI as a <u>whole</u>, which makes it difficult to score them, as users often come from a particular department and don't know about other departments. Scoring a 'five' on a statement would actually require a benchmark – a comparative case. But that does not always exist...
- There is a need for a new dimension on <u>Social Entrepreneurship!</u>

On the HEInnovate statements & dimensions

- The (many!) HEInnovate case studies on the HEInnovate website are quite broad and positive, and our partners found them difficult to use for getting inspiration about the <u>actions</u> to undertake to become more entrepreneurial. So, we suggest to deduce ways of making their contents more useful and accessible. BeyondScale constructed a first version of so-called <u>Inspiration Fiches</u> that show Challenges, Interventions, Solutions, Inputs, Barriers. They can inspire the users to start Actions. Recommended actions, so to speak.
- Learning with others <u>DigiBuddy</u>
