The Digi Buddy Platform

The Digi Buddy platform is a digital tool that supports higher education institutions finding institutional partners for peer learning and assists their collaboration and capacity building during institutional transformation with evidence-based tools.

The Digi Buddy platform has already been tested by several Higher Education Institutions, and now it is your turn!

A closer Look on Digi Buddy

Digi Buddy was designed and implemented within the Erasmus+ project BeyondScale. The HEInnovate dimensions (Digital Transformation & Capability, Entrepreneurial Teaching and Learning, Knowledge Exchange, Measuring Impact, Preparing and Supporting Entrepreneurs) were used so as to support the HEIs to find “buddies” based on their field of interest.

The DIGI Buddy platform has the following three main functionalities:

- To enable HEIs to find matching institutions that face similar challenges.
- To facilitate collaboration, networking, and mentorship among HEIs.
- To provide access to evidence about how institutions become more entrepreneurial via the "Inspiration Fiches".


The "Inspiration Fiches" summarize evidence from scientific literature and resources provided by the HEInnovate platform and BeyondScale.

They provide a menu of typical challenges that higher education institutions face when becoming more entrepreneurial.

The fiches list interventions higher education institutions employed to respond to challenges, the inputs used, the barriers faced, and the solutions institutions have developed.

They include answers to the following questions:

- **Challenge/Goals** – Which goals should be achieved through the change process?
- **Interventions** – What interventions are there to achieve the goals?
- **Input** – What inputs or resources must be expended for this, and what special requirements must these inputs meet?
- **Barriers & Solutions** – What problems can arise and what can be done to overcome them?



Each registered Higher Education Institutions has a separate profile where information on the university, e.g. location, area of expertise, degree levels and contact data are presented.
